INCIDENT REVIEW:

Dump valve broke on gas well I-80 at the 19mm – oil spill I-80 at the 9.5 mm – oil spill SWAT call at the Radisson Sharon Tube – Sulfuric Acid leak.

Due to a recent incident at a facility, Frank Jannetti suggested that the facilities should be asked to attend a meeting to review their Off-Site Response Plan.

REGION 13 REPORT:

Frank Jannetti provided the report.

The Region funding is still in question. Homeland Security Funds are on the chopping block.

TRAINING: Nine classes have been scheduled, 3 have been canceled.

OLD BUSINESS:

Decon tent has been delivered, and training will be scheduled.

Radio Project update: Portable radios are ordered for PD, FD and EMS. Environmental historical preservation studies are being done at all 7 tower sites.

Hazmat Team Options: Act 165 Rewrite. They want to raise the chemical and planning fees significantly and give funding to the private companies. That was met with much resistance from the counties. There was a discussion to partner with Butler Hazmat team. Frank and John will meet with Butler to gather more information and have another discussion at the next committee meeting.
