PROFESSIONAL CONNECTIONS EXPERIENCE

The Professional Connections Experience (PCE) is a summer program created by the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) with the goal of providing high school students with disabilities the opportunity to learn important work skills and connect them to jobs in the community.

The PCE is a 2-week/60-hour program. Week 1 consists of group presentations on workplace readiness and job exploration. In week 2, the students explore the world of work through job shadows, informational and mock interviews, or in-person workplace tours and the acquisition of prerequisite work documents (e.g., photo ID, work permits and financial documentation).

Students who successfully complete the program by attending all activities will receive a stipend of \$625 at the completion of the program.
