What is the Q Academy?

The Q Academy will provide mentoring and educational support of male youth in grades 7-12 who seek positive male influences in their lives. Adult male mentoring and work related exposure and experiences are instrumental in developing and building positive self-esteem, a sense of community responsibility and serve as an introduction to employment opportunities and career development. This mentorship program will strengthen the family unit, build up capable, responsible members of our community and reduce poverty by preparing individuals for the job force and connecting them with employment opportunities.





How does it work?

Prince of Peace Center will identify and secure mentor leaders to facilitate educational classes within our local school districts.

Prince of Peace Center will strengthen community partnerships with local businesses who can serve as both a stream for mentors and job opportunities.

Prince of Peace Center will set up an incentive program for each candidate to teach financial literacy.

What is the impact?

Engaging in partnerships with local leaders and businesses will offer candidates mentorship, employment prospects and cultivate a sense of community responsibility. Furthermore, these partnerships will facilitate meaningful connections with mentors and leaders. Central to this program is the enhancement of interpersonal skills, equipping participants with the tools necessary to excel as fathers, husbands, employees, and valuable members of society.
