SAP is available to students in kindergarten through 12th grade. A SAP Team is made up of school staff, a SAP liaison, and other community partners. The SAP team will help find assistance within the vou school, and if needed, services in the community. In Pennsylvania, every school district is required to have a plan for identifying and assisting students who experience barriers to learning and success in school. As the parent/guardian, you are an important part of the team. Information is confidential, and the team will respect you and your child's privacy at all times.
