Working in manufacturing, including as an operator of Computer Numerical Control (CNC) equipment, requires a high degree of focused attention to detail and following clear instructions and processes. CNC equipment is used to shape and cut materials as part of the manufacturing process. The manufacturing industry currently is in short supply of CNC operators, and you can be part of a vital talent pipeline!

The Uniquely Abled Academy at Crawford Tech

UAA is a 23-week program of in-class instruction by precision machining instructors at Crawford Tech, along with a focus on job readiness skills, facility tours, and job shadows.

Students will learn the basics of operating CNC machines, combined with using quality control instruments, shop mathematics, and blueprint reading.
Graduates will qualify for entry level positions in manufacturing.

Trainees must be a least 18 years' old
(or will be 18 by completion of UAA)
