# UPCOMING CHANGES TO MEDICAID

## What You'll Learn:

Join Pennsylvania Health Law Project for a webinar for those who work in or live in Northwest Pennsylvania. Significant changes to Pennsylvania's Medicaid program will start at the end of 2026 and beginning of 2027 as the state implements H.R.1 (also called the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act"). This law, passed in July 2025, makes the biggest cuts to Medicaid since the program began in 1965 and is expected to result in more than 300,000 Pennsylvanians losing Medicaid. Some of the most significant cuts to Medicaid in the law are expected to start in January 2027 and impact people who currently are in the Medicaid Expansion population in the following ways: new work reporting requirements; more frequent eligibility renewals; and shorter period of retroactive eligibility available to help with past medical bills. Starting October 1st, immigrant access to Medicaid will be restricted. This training will cover these changes and more to help people better understand them and prepare for them.
