Announcement of Worker’s Memorial Service to be held in the Courthouse Rotunda on 4/27/2018. Event is sponsored by the Mercer County Labor Council.

Logan stated that Fiscal is disappointed in the state’s mandate to approve the new voting machines as the current system is effective and safely records votes reliably.

Greenburg of the Voter Registration/Elections Office responded to the press release by the State concerning the mandate to have an agreement in place by 12/31/2019 for a new voting system that is secure and auditable. Cost could escalate up to \$2.5MM for the changeover. As the technology advances, the life span of the voting system could diminish. The implementation date for the new system is April, 2020 so as not to interfere with a Presidential election cycle. The Election Code is antiquated and many issues remain unresolved.

The Commissioners asked about security at voting precincts, especially schools. Greenburg stated that schools are accessible and the request is to keep them as a voting site. One recommendation is to close the school (schedule an In-Service day) on election days so there are no security issues with the students and the public. This is because some schools do not have a separate dedicated entrance for voters to enter the precinct site.
