## General Discussion Items: See Below.

Voter Registration/Election Director Hall reported that poll books will be printed next week. He reminded everyone that the last day to request a ballot is Tuesday, 10/31/2023. Ballots must be returned by 8 pm on Election Day. An elector must return their own ballot if it is not returned in the mail. Approximately 57% of the mail-in ballots have been returned as of this date.

An elector will be required to surrender their ballot and envelope in order to vote, only if they a received a mail-in ballot but changed their mind and decided to vote in person. If they do not surrender the mail-in ballot, they may vote with a provisional ballot.

Hall confirmed that the PA 2024 Primary date will remain as previously scheduled in April.

Commissioners reported on the success of the Veterans Stand Down and Resource Fair held at the Hickory VFW. Sixty-eight vendors were present and over 250 meals were served to veterans. This is the ninth Stand Down in Mercer County where VA staff and volunteers provide food, clothing, and health screenings to homeless and at-risk Veterans. In addition, Veterans also receive referrals for health care, housing solutions, employment, substance use treatment, mental health counseling and other essential services.
