- Sheriff Callahan reported the West Middlesex V.F.W. is hosting the Sportsman's Expo in the evening from 6:00pm to 8:00pm.
- Building & Grounds Director Brian Gruber reported the Insurance Adjuster was at the Courthouse earlier in the week and viewed the damage to the clock in the dome.
- Elections Director Thad Hall recalled the time he personally met Proclamation recipient Robert Hodgson and his wife. He also provided up-dates on ballots, voting machine testing, ballot curing, and training pole workers.
