### Wardens Report:

Warden McDuffie begins by stating that for the month of May there were 193 commitments and 201 releases for an average daily population of 207. He states that he plans on opening up the Hotel unit in the next few weeks and will be getting this running back to normal. Warden McDuffie states that he has nothing further to report at this time.

President Pete Acker asks for a motion to approve the Warden's Report. Commissioner Finley makes the first motion and it was seconded by Secretary Judge Wallace. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.

## **IPP Report:**

IPP Director Tyler Shoaf begins by stating that for the month of May there were 73 referrals, 64 successful completions and 7 failures/revocations for a total of 611 participants. Savings to the county based on 1346 jail bed days saved had a total of \$475,000. There were 484 community service hours completed which made a savings to the work sites of \$3,511. Currently, there are 25 participants in Treatment court, 21 in Veterans court and 10 in Mental Health court.

President Pete Acker asks for a motion to approve the IPP Report. Commissioner Finley makes the first motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Coleman. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.
