He acknowledged the employees in the Fiscal Office, Treasurer's Office, and the Controller's Office for their work and dedication in completing the project. Controller Sherman recognized Jared Hoffacker, First Deputy of the Controller's Office, with a plaque for his distinguished work on the Oracle Software Project along with Gail Moon, Second Deputy of the Controller's Office, for their dedication on the completion of the software project.

**Questions of the Media:** Caleb Stright of the Record Argus inquired about the impact to the County of the State Budget not being finalized and if there were any updates on the situation with the State Budget. Commissioner McGonigle advised the Commissioners did speak with Senator Brooks and they would not be back in session for the budget meetings this week. Commissioner McGonigle spoke about the impacts on the County Departments such as CYS, 911, and Domestic Relations.
