Approval of Minutes:

President Pete Acker asks for a motion to approve the February Prison Board minutes due to the March meeting being cancelled. Controller Stephen Sherman makes the first motion, and it was seconded by Sheriff Callahan. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.

Wardens Report:

Warden McDuffie begins by stating that for the month of March there were 190 commitments and 185 releases with an average daily population of 202. He states that the facility is in the process of getting ready for PrimeCare’s NCCHC inspection which will be occurring next week. Warden McDuffie also tells the board that all law enforcement agencies must obtain a subpoena if wanting any kind of inmate phone recordings. This will eliminate any possible wiretap violations.

President Pete Acker asks for a motion to approve the Wardens Report. Sheriff Callahan makes the first

motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Coleman. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.

IPP Report:

IPP Director Tyler Shoaf begins by stating that for the month of March there were 75 referrals, 59 successful completions and 10 failures with a total of 555 clients. There were 565 community service hours completed which created savings to the work sites of \$4,000. The total amount of Domestic Violence fees collected was \$1,000.

President Pete Acker asks for a motion to approve the IPP Report. Vice President Timothy McGonigle makes the first motion and it was seconded by Sheriff Callahan. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.


