- Kaitlin Struthers commented on the issues surrounding local libraries, including financial issues. Mercer County libraries are not State funded and rely on local funds. The Mercer County Librarians have met and discussed what is needed to become better funded through a Library System with the State. Unfortunately, the statutory formula for State aid has been frozen since 2001. The Librarians are hoping local legislators, such as Senator Michele Brooks and Representative Tim Bonner could help with that cause.
