INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:
1. To vote you must blacken the () completely. An oval blackened () to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate. 2. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval () completely to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose. 3. Mark the ballot with a blue, black, or blue-black pen. Your ballot will be counted by an optical scanner and if you use anything else it may not be readable by the scanner. 4. If you make a mistake, request a new ballot.

WARNING - If you receive a mail ballot and return your voted ballot by the deadline, you may not vote at your polling place on Election Day. If you are unable to return your voted ballot by the deadline, you may only vote a provisional ballot at your polling place on Election Day. However, if you surrender your mail ballot and return envelope to the Judge of Elections to be voided, you can vote a regular ballot.
