

AMENDMENT NO. 42 TO ORDINANCE 3-1980

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 1980 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COUNTY OF MERCER TO SET WEIGHT LIMITS ON COUNTY-OWNED AND COUNTY-MAINTAINED BRIDGES AND TO CLOSE COUNTY-OWNED AND COUNTY-MAINTAINED BRIDGES PENDING REPAIR OF THE SAME PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE COUNTY OF MERCER IN THE VEHICLE CODE, ACT OF JUNE 17, 1976, P.L. 162 NO 81 § 1 ET SEQ, 75 PA C.S.A. § 101 ET SEQ." BY AMENDING WEIGHT LIMITS ON DESIGNATED COUNTY OWNED BRIDGES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer, Pennsylvania, has previously enacted into law Ordinance 3 of 1980 for the purposes, policies and by the authority set forth in the Preamble of the said Ordinance No. 3-1980, the Board of Commissioner of Mercer County, Pennsylvania, hereby intend to amend the aforementioned Ordinance as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Section One (1) of Ordinance 3-1980 shall be amended to read as follows:

MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF CERTAIN BRIDGES

The maximum permissible weight limits on the County-owned bridges listed shall be as follows:

Section 2. Section Two (2) of Ordinance 3-1980 shall be amended to read as follows:

CLOSING OF CERTAIN BRIDGES

The bridges listed below shall be closed and shall remain closed until such bridges are repaired:

Section 3. Other Bridges

All other County-owned bridges shall be opened for use by the public. These bridges, although not posted, are restricted to the maximum weight restriction of 80,000 pounds as permitted under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. Bridge Department to Post Bridges

The Bridge Department of the County of Mercer shall have the authority to post the County owned bridges of the County with signs pursuant to this ordinance.

Section 5. Penalties

Any person operating a vehicle or combination upon a highway or bridge in violation of a prohibition or restriction imposed under Section 1 is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75, except that any person convicted of operating a vehicle with a gross weight limit in excess of a posted weight shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150 plus \$150 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum allowable weight. Upon conviction for a violation of Section 4902 (relating to Restrictions on Use of Highways and Bridges), a surcharge of \$225 will be assessed.

Section 6. Severability

The words, phrases, clauses, sentences, and sections of this ordinance are severable so that of any one or more of such words, phrases, clauses, sentences, or sections is unconstitutional or illegal than that unconstitutional or illegal portion shall be severed so as not to render any other word, phrase, clause, sentence or section unconstitutional or illegal.

Section 7.




