Resolution to authorize the County Solicitor to execute a Joint Petition to Abandon Bridge 0199 located on West County Line Road. The bridge is located in both Greene Township, Mercer County and West Shenango Township, Crawford County, and jointly owned by both counties. West Shenango Township will assume ownership of the bridge and all maintenance responsibilities. In exchange, Mercer County will provide West Shenango Township with a one-time payment of \$20,000.00. These monies have been previously disbursed to Mercer County from the State for the bridge's maintenance.
