- Commissioner McGonigle thanked Father Wittman for being at the meeting and for the powerful words, saying they are words to live by.

- Commissioner Coleman attended a Food Bank Meeting in the morning and advised the Food Bank served over 5,400 meals during the summer which is about 9,000 pounds of food. Since July 2022, the Food Bank has doubled the amount of food distributed in the communities.
