- Elections Director Thad Hall was asked by Commissioner McGonigle about the rental of ES&S equipment that was needed for the elections recount. Mr. Hall advises since the recount was cancelled, the County will not need to pay for the equipment. Commissioner Coleman asked if the candidate tracking software for 2025 will be available to the public online. Mr. Hall advised a request could be sent to his office for the information and he would mail the information to the requester.
