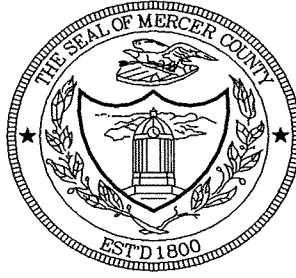

Approval of Minutes:

Vice President Timothy McGonigle asks for a motion to approve the September 2025 meeting minutes. Sheriff Callahan makes the first motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Finley. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.

Wardens Report:

Chief Deputy James Scott begins by stating that for the month of September there were 193 commitments and 186 releases with an average daily population of 197. Overtime hours have slightly increased due to staffing levels but should soon return to normal.

Vice President Timothy McGonigle asks for a motion to approve the Wardens Report. Secretary Judge Wallace makes the first motion and it was seconded by Sheriff Tim Callahan. Voice vote was unanimous, motion carried.

IPP Report:

IPP Director Tyler Shoaf begins by stating that for the month of September there were 88 referrals, 69 successful completions and 12 failures/revocations for a total of 194 clients. Total savings to the county between Pre-Trial TASC and house arrest had a total of \$527,000. Currently, there are 28 participants in Treatment Court, 20 in Veteran's Court and 10 in Mental Health Court. Director Shoaf continues by stating that he also has recently hired a new person for the Treatment Court Supervisor who will start soon.

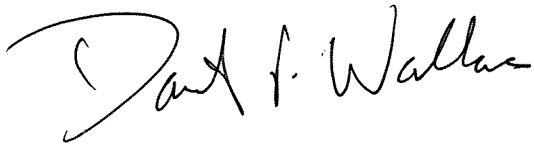
