ELECTRONICS & HHW (ECSR will collect payment in the form of credit card, cash, or check for these items)

Electronics - TV's & Monitors 45 cents/pound

Electronics - All others (Towers, printers, microwaves, radios, VCRs, etc.) 25 cents/pound

Household Hazardous Wastes

-Paint: \$1.50 per pound

-Corrosives/Oxidizers/Flammables: \$4 per pound

-Used Oil/Antifreeze: \$2 per pound

-Pesticides/Herbicides: \$6 per pound

Batteries & Fluorescent Lights - All varieties \$3 per pound

APPLIANCES & TIRES (Tri-County CleanWays will collect payment in the form of cash or check for these items)

Appliances - Freon-containing (refrigerators, air-conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.) \$25 per item

Appliances - All others (washers, hot-water tanks, stoves, etc.) \$5 per item

Tires (Limit—20 Tires per Person)

- Passenger Vehicle: \$3 per tire

- Tractor Trailer: \$15 per tire

- Passenger/Light Truck On Rims: \$10 per tire

- Light Truck: \$5 per tire

- Tractor Trailer on Rims: \$25 per tire
