GREENVILLE BOROUGH RECYCLING PROGRAM

Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses are required to recycle at their curb or place of business.

Materials Collected:

- Glass bottles and jars,
- Metal **cans** (Aluminum, steel, and tin cans, including empty aerosol and paint cans with the lids removed)
- Plastic **bottles & jugs**
- Corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspapers, including inserts
- Mixed office paper
- Junk mail

Please note that only bottles, jars, and cans are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, tubing, etc.

Businesses must also recycle, but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: Every week on the same day as trash pickup.

Spring/Fall Cleanup: No.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Yes. Contact Tri-County Industries for acceptable items or to purchase tags.

Leaves: Yes. All leaf waste must be in bio-degradable bags, which can be purchased at most hardware and home improvement stores.

Christmas Trees: Yes. Live trees will be collected by Tri-County Industries in December, January and February. Remove adornments and do not place the tree in bags or carts. Cut the tree so the branch spread is no more than 4 feet across and trunk pieces are no longer than 5 feet.

Electronics/Household Hazardous Waste: Yes. Residents may call Tri-County Industries at 1-800-457-8202 or visit www.tricountyind.com to set up a collection appointment for acceptable items.
