Introduction

The directory is organized into three primary sections.

- 1. <u>"Municipal Drop-off and Curbside Programs"</u>: Listed by municipality and includes contact information, materials collected, and times of collection.
- 2. <u>"Listing by Materials"</u>: This list is arranged by material and shows where materials can be recycled.
- 3. <u>"Alphabetical List of Recyclers"</u>: Lists Recyclers in alphabetical order including their address, telephone number, and material accepted.



When You Shop:

Packaging makes up more than 30% of consumer waste and uses 10 cents of every shopping dollar. Become an environmentally aware shopper and avoid buying overpackaged products which add to our waste disposal problem.

- Buy durable goods
- Repair and restore used items
- Buy items you can reuse
- Avoid excess packaging
- Buy items made from recycled materials

At Work and School:

- Start simply. Reduce waste by using both sides of the paper for copying and memos.
- Recycle office paper, aluminum cans, leaves and corrugated cardboard. Remember, it's the law!
- Use reusable coffee mugs.
- Buy only what you need.
- Do a waste audit to see what you are throwing away in the trash. Remember you pay for waste twice ... once when you purchase it and second to throw it away.

Frequently Asked Questions About Curbside Recycling

What is "Curbside Recycling?"

Curbside recycling is simply having recyclables picked up at your home. It does not mean that a physical "curb" is required.

Am I required to recycle curbside?

All residents and businesses in the following municipalities are required by state and local laws to recycle curbside:

- City of Sharon
- City of Hermitage
- City of Farrell
- Grove City Borough
- Greenville Borough

These are called "Mandated Municipalities."

Residents and businesses of all other Mercer County municipalities are not required to recycle curbside but are encouraged to do so voluntarily. See <u>"I live in a Municipality where I am not required to Recycle Curbside but I would like to do so. What options do I have for curbside recycling?"</u> on page 5 for more information.

What can I recycle?

Most recycling programs in Mercer County collect recyclables via "single stream" recycling. Single stream recycling is designed to make recycling as easy as possible. All of the recyclable materials are mixed together in the same container. There is no need to separate them.

The following materials are typically included in single stream recycling programs:

- #1 through #7 Plastic Bottles
- Clear & Colored Glass Bottles/Jars
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel, Tin, and bimetal cans
- Magazines
- Corrugated Cardboard

- Newspaper
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Junk Mail

<u>If it is not on the list - it belongs in the trash or recycled elsewhere</u>. This directory is a good place to start for finding other recycling options. Remember, if it is not on this list it will NOT get recycled when it gets to a recycling center.

What are the advantages of curbside recycling?

Curbside recycling is:

- EASY All materials can be mixed together in the same container.
- <u>CONVENIENT</u> You can do it at your own home without making a special trip to a recycling site.
- <u>ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY</u> No more using your vehicle and your gas to drive to a recycling site.

I live in a municipality where I am not required to recycle curbside. What options do I have if I want curbside recycling service?

Some Mercer County residents that don't live in a mandated municipality may be able to recycle curbside. It depends on their hauler. Contact your current trash hauler to see if they provide recycling service in your community. Currently, customers of Tri-County Industries in many Mercer County municipalities have access to curbside recycling service.

What kind of recycling bin can I use for curbside recycling?

Recycling bins vary. Some haulers and municipalities will provide you with a container. You can also purchase your own container through a local hardware or department store. Wheeled containers and carts are easy to move and provide adequate room for all your recyclables. Traditional bins may be used as well.

What about Polystyrene (Styrofoam), Toys, Windows, etc.?

<u>These items are TRASH</u>... plain and simple.

Including items not listed for recycling, contaminates your recyclables and significantly increases the cost. All contaminates must be removed before the material can be recycled. None of these items will get recycled at a recycling center!

What about Plastic Bags?

<u>Plastic bags do not belong in your recycle bin</u> and will not get recycled if you include them. In fact, plastic bags are a major problem at recycling centers as they must be ripped open to free the recyclables and they impact recycling equipment resulting in system shut downs, often multiple times daily. Plastic bags can be recycled at most grocery stores.



What about Leaves?

All Mandated Municipalities offer leaf waste collection. Contact your municipality for details.

Electronics/HHW: Yes. Residents can call ECS&R at 1-866-815-0016 to schedule a once per month, curbside pickup of acceptable materials.
